Samcheok Eco Dry Material (commissioned operation of KC Green Materials, CEO Kisuh Park) announced on the 1st that they exchanged MOU for the product development with Korea Southern Power and With Emtech by using

Samcheok Eco Dry Material began to produce sand for dry material and mixture from 2018 by recycling fly ashes from Samcheok Power in the Korea Southern Power, and they exchanged MOU for the product development with Asia Cement, Korea Southern Power and With Emtech by using recycling fly ashes from Samcheok Power in the Korea Southern Power.

Artificial aggregates produced from Samcheok Eco Dry Material is an eco-friendly aggregate produced by physical and chemical combination through hydration react using CaO, a fly ash, which expects innovative development in terms of recycling wastes and resource recirculation. By means of research on the product application and facility improvement, it will be applied to mortar products and cement products of Asia Cement from 2019 onwards..
