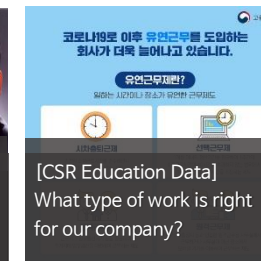

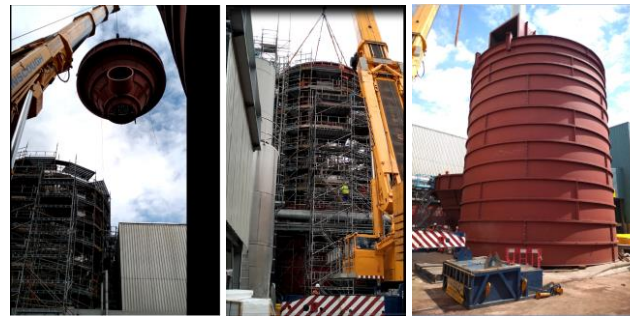

Lodge Cottrell completes another Waste to Energy Plant with Zero Accidents.

This was a very intricate outage as the client had called Lodge Cottrell in as the original build had collapsed 600mm and required significant structural design and re-build requirements. With a set time span the site team under the command of Graham and Terry and the structural design support of Judy, went about stripping out, designing, building and installing a new reactor shell, hopper cone system, new penthouse and crossover duct.

This was not as simple as it sounds with the cone having to be fitted in place first, weighing 23 Tonnes, with a diameter of 10 meters and 7 meters high as you can see from the photographs opposite the tolerance for fitting was just very tight.

Once this was in place the next major problem to overcome was, the lifting of the reactor shell which again with a diameter of 10 meters, having a height of 14 meters and weighing 50 Tonne again having to fit inside the scaffolding was again no easy task. But with the support of a good pro-active team it went in at the first attempt and without any problems.

The resultant effect of the great work undertaken by the team is that Lodge has been commissioned to prepare a structural integrity report for the second reactor, which has subsequently confirmed its major defects and the requirement to replace on both safety and operational grounds. Our associated offer has been submitted to the customer and expect to conclude the second reactor replacement in 2021. (End)

Among them, beachcombing was held at Songjeong Beach in Gangneung on October 29th as an environmental improvement activity of the local community. KC Green Materials located at Gangneung, KC Cottrell Gangneung site staff, and KC Green Holdings staff participated.

On the beachcombing day, Yonggyu Kim, CEO of OceanKind, gave a lecture under the theme of <Travel of Sea Garbage> on how much garbage is thrown into the sea every year, and how the garbage dumped in the sea affects the marine ecosystem, and then walked along Songjeong Beach to collect garbage.

Afterwards, there was a time to collect the garbage collected by each group and analyze what kind of garbage there was, and the analyzed data was uploaded under the name of 'KCGH, KCGS, KCKR' named after the companies participating in this activity on the Coast Cleanup Data website (www.coastcleanupdata.org), which collects beach waste data from around the world, the name of the company that participated in this activity.

Employees who participated in this beachcombing commented, "It was amazing how the trash that should not be on the beach came to the beach", "It is important to separate trash well, but above all, zero waste that does not generate any trash is important." KC Green Materials signed agreement to support on artificial soil development



On November 2, KC Green Materials signed an agreement to support research on artificial soil development using livestock manure with Korea Southern Power Co., Ltd. and Samcheok City.

This agreement was established to utilize livestock manure generated by livestock farms and fluidized bed boiler power produced by Korea Southern Power Co., Ltd.

Through this agreement, KC Green Materials tests livestock manure composting technology and artificial soil manufacturing technology and invests funds for commercialization.

Korea Southern Power Co., Ltd. supplies raw materials and provides related information, and Samcheok City provides administrative support related to the commercialization of artificial soil using livestock manure and gives the advices for mutual cooperation.

The development of artificial soil using livestock manure is not simply ended with research, but the product is commercialized and local livestock manure and power generation by-products are not only recycled as eco-friendly materials, but also expanded to job creation through new factory construction. Therefore, it is expected to greatly contribute to the vitalization of the local economy. (End)

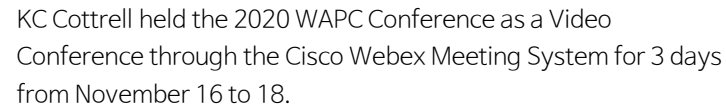

KC Solar & Energy wins contract for construction of farming solar power plant in Paju



On November 19, KC Solar & Energy obtained an order for the farming solar power planting model demonstration support project announced in Paju City. This project is not a competitive bidding, but is a project undertaken by a private contract with Paju City based on a patent for farming solar power generation device owned by KC Solar & Energy, and thus is more meaningful.

A farming solar power plant is a power plant that combines farming industry and solar power generation to enable solar power generation while maintaining the existing farming industry, and is expected to be a future solar power plant in the future.

This power generation facility is a self-consumption type facility for the Paju-si Agricultural Technology Center, not a power supply type business, and was designed with a total capacity of 50 kW.

The construction commenced on November 26, 2020, with a process period of about 30 days, and on December 28, all processes were completed until the pre-use inspection, and the completion inspection was conducted.

KC Solar & Energy is establishing as a leading company in the farming solar power generation business by adding the results of the Paju 50kW farming solar power generation facility in addition to the performance of a total 400kW farming solar power generation facility promoted with Korea East-West Power Co., Ltd.

Currently, the period of temporary use for other uses of farmland is limited to allow the project to proceed only for a total of 8 years due to an extension provision of 5 years from the first 3 years, so the private farming solar power generation project was struggling. However, the Democratic Party's lawmaker Park Jeong has proposed a related bill and an amendment such as extending the temporary alternate use of farmland (first 10 years + 10 years extension) and permitting the farming solar power generation project in the agricultural promotion zone so that the solar power generation project can be mitigated. Hence, private-led farming solar power generation is expected to be commercialized.

KC Solar & Energy is continuously developing farming solar power generation project with other organizations such as local governments and power generation subsidiaries, and is continuously preparing to become a leading company when revitalizing the private market in the future. (End)

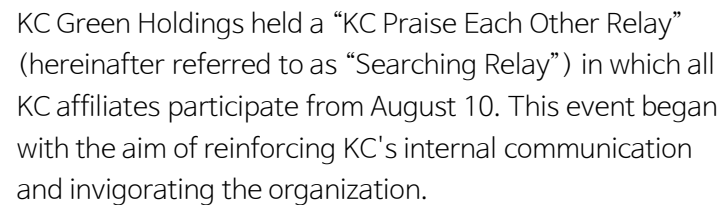

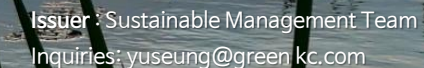

KC Solar & Energy, along with Seoul Energy Corporation and Korea Western Power Co., Ltd., will use the parking lot and rooftops of 20 Lotte Mart branches nationwide to promote a total 4.5 MW solar power generation project.

The three companies established Sunlight Power Plant Co., Ltd. (SPC) with each other for this project, and the shareholders' agreement signing ceremony was held on December 1, 2020. Through this signing ceremony, the three companies have each share (Seoul Energy Corporation (52.3%), Korea Western Power (42.6%), KC Solar & Energy (5.1%)), share roles such as construction management, REC contract, and operation management, and jointly enter into full-scale commercialization.

In the first half of 2021, they are planned to be installed at all 20 branches and put into operation.

Through this project, it is expected that electricity that can be used by 4,000 households for one year will be produced, and about 2,288 tons of carbon dioxide can be reduced.

KC Solar & Energy participated in the bidding for the selection of O&M business operator to use this project as a bridgehead for expanding competitiveness as a management operator, not just as a power plant business operator, and was selected as a business operator on December 23, 2020, and additional management and operation revenues were secured in the long term (15 years).

KC Solar & Energy intends to actively participate in and expand similar types of businesses in the future, and will make it a business that can be linked not only to power generation businesses, but also to EPC and O&M orders. (End)

In December, KC EnviroServices sought a business cooperation partners to revitalize the sewage sludge fueling business, while internally establishing a forum to strengthen the unity and to discuss long-term plans for the fuel coal business and the next year's work.

First, on December 8, Kepko Energy Solutions signed a “business cooperation agreement in the field of organic waste resources energy.”

This agreement with Kepko Energy Solutions was signed for business exchange and technical cooperation in a consensus to recycle sewage sludge, a waste resource, as a new renewable energy fuel for thermal power plants.

KC EnviroServices established a subsidiary called KC Green Energy in December 2018 to carry out the sewage sludge fuel coal business, and completed the plant in May 2020.

In addition, Kepko Energy Solutions is a company founded by joint venture between KEPCO and Korea's five major power generation companies, and is promoting new energy businesses in various fields. It is hoped that this agreement will enable the two companies to actively exchange and create synergies that take a leap forward in terms of both business and technology. (End)

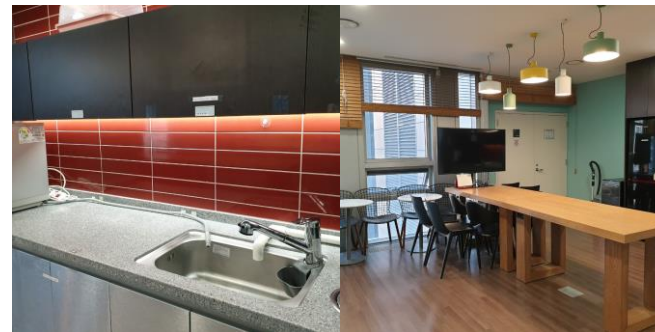

Companies that have directly verified the efficiency of telecommuting that there is no obstacle to work even if they are not in the same space as many Korean companies inevitably began working from home in 2020 due to COVID-19, are reviewing various types of flexible work systems that preemptively respond to the pandemic of not knowing when it will come back when the COVID-19 is over and increase work efficiency.

The flexible work system refers to a work system that allows flexible adjustment of working hours or places, not working from 9 to 6, and working at a company office, and the time-flexible system is a time-varying work system, an optional work system, and a system with flexibility in place is a telecommuting system and remote work system.

In the case of implementing the time-varying work or the optional work system, there is an advantage of increasing work efficiency and keeping the work balance by using time for self-development and personal work by working more when work concentration is high or adjusting rush hours. In addition, when the telecommuting or remote work system is implemented, there are advantages such that employees can reduce the burden of commuting, and it can be environmentally friendly by reducing carbon dioxide generated by means of transportation when commuting. On the company side, it can also increase employee satisfaction, lower turnover rate, and increase productivity and efficiency of work.

As of 2020, it has been 15 years when the five-day workweek system was implemented, and Koreans still do a lot of work, but their productivity is evaluated as low. In an era where diversity is recognized, is there a need for a change in the way of working outside of the uniform working form again? (End)

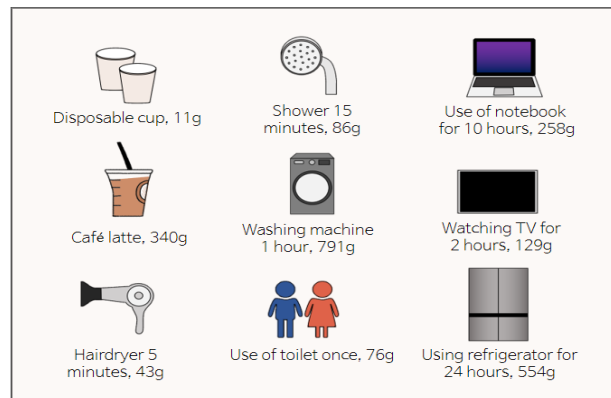

How to reduce carbon footprint?

What is a carbon footprint? It refers to the total amount of greenhouse gases produced by individuals or groups. As climate change becomes more serious, the term “climate emergency” is used and each government is aiming to be carbon neutral. At this point, reducing the individual's carbon footprint has become more of an obligation than an option.

Amount of carbon emission generated everyday



According to the Global Carbon Project, Korea's per capita carbon emission in 2018 is 12.4 tons. One 30-year-old pine tree absorbs about 6.4 kg of carbon a year, but the amount of carbon that one tree absorbs is too small to absorb the carbon emitted by the Korean people, so it is calculated that 1,879 trees per person should be planted.

Planting trees to prevent the climate crisis is also important, but the fastest thing that can be practiced is reducing the individual's carbon footprint.

Reducing the carbon footprint in daily life

- ✓ Avoid unnecessary consumption
 - : As the convenience of online shopping increases, consumption also increases. However, when you consume a product, packaging materials (box, cushioning material, cold insulation material, styrofoam, etc.) are shipped together with the product. If possible, products should be purchased at once and unnecessary consumption should be avoided.
- ✓ Slow fashion rather than fast fashion
 - : Usually 99% of the clothes thrown away at home are recyclable, but most are deposited in landfills or incinerated. As fast fashion that is produced and consumed quickly like fast food has established itself, it is said that as many as 50 fashions pass a year. Now, clothing recycling and careful fashion consumption through slow fashion (sustainable fashion) are needed.
- ✓ Reducing digital carbon footprint
 - : When we work on data with digital devices, it connects to the data center that handles the work. In a data center where a lot of data is accumulated, the sub needs to be cooled to maintain the proper temperature and humidity, which consumes a lot of power and generates greenhouse gases.
 - Efforts are required to power-save mode, lower the monitor brightness, clean up old mails, and download instead of streaming.

As you try to reduce carbon footprint, your daily discomfort will increase. However, the time has come to accept that this discomfort is a sustainable life and overcome the climate crisis.

The first GWP theme in 2021 is reducing carbon footprint.

As President Biden announced plans to rejoin the Paris Agreement on Climate Change, from which former President Trump withdrew, the global economy's attention has once again focused on reducing carbon emissions. Activities such as the development of technologies to reduce carbon in the process of producing products and regulating countries and companies to reduce carbon emissions are important, but the efforts of individuals to reduce carbon in daily life are also very important.

How many traces are you leaving on the Earth? What efforts should I make to reduce carbon footprint I left?
